- Essay
 - In 500 words or less tell us why you're interested in being a programmer and/or developer within the Architecture and Interior Design space.
- Resume
 - Include contact information and education.
- Work Sample
 - Provide a link to your portfolio, GitHub, or personal website showcasing your work.
- Recommendation Letter
 - Include a letter of recommendation from a professor or professional mentor who can speak to your future as a programmer and/or developer.
- Headshot (optional)
 - By providing your headshot you are providing consent for Corgan's internal use and external announcement usage.
- Internship Application
 - Submit an online application to our IT Software Development Internship through our <u>careers page</u>.

SELECTION CRITERIA & PROCESS

Judges will select winners based on the listed requirements, quality of work portfolios, and an interest in the industry.
